Prime & Store Cattle

Prime Steers made from \$3.80 - \$3.96 for the best finished Cattle. Friesian Steers made \$3.70 at 541kg. Prime Heifers sold to similar values to previous sales, \$3.76 - \$3.88, they were all Beef Friesian x this week. The Prime Bulls were the highlight these sold for \$3.80 for straight Jersey Bulls, with Beef Bulls making \$4.14 - \$4.20 kg. Hereford Cows made \$3.02 at 596kgs.

In the Store Cattle pens, Lees Valley Station sold 400 Angus, Hereford & Angus Hereford x Steers, they made between \$1560 -\$1860 head with weights of 395 – 420kg (\$4.20ckg). PWF Boag sent 38 16-month-old Angus & Angus Hereford x Heifers ranging from 250 – 320kg and they made between \$960 - \$1340, \$3.85 -\$4.22ckg.
