#### Prime & Store Cattle

A smaller yarding of Prime Cattle today at Coalgate. Prime Steers made \$3.70 - \$3.98 kg at 480 – 735kg. Heifers made \$3.20 - \$4.04 kg, with dry Dairy Heifers making \$2.68 - \$3.20. Cows sold very well with a stand out line from Kakapotahi Farm making \$2.93 - \$3.00kg at 605 – 732kg. There was a number of Bulls yarded, Bulls weighing 414 – 770kg made \$3.60 - \$4.12 & the heavier Bulls at 910 – 1125kg made \$2.60 - \$3.20 kg.

There was less for the buyers to pick from in the Store Cattle, but the market held up well.
